It doesn't always work when siblings try to work together, but sisters Tracy Holder and Louise Toner are going from strength to strength with their catering business. The pair have worked successfully together for 14 years and now run three cafés, including Joseph's Kitchen Café just off Billerica High Street.



'Our relationship just works,' says Tracy, 'we both love to cook and we just don't seem to disagree over business matters.'

The café serves dishes that can't be found elsewhere. 'That's why we're popular' Tracy comments, 'Our customers know they will always find something different on the menu, all home cooked, using ingredients from local independent suppliers.'

Poached egg on toasted sourdough bread is one of the most popular items on the breakfast list, whilst dishes such as baked sweet potatoes with a choice of fillings, Moroccan meatballs with cous cous or a healthy quinoa salad may be on the lunchtime menu. Also for the health conscious, a freshly made

apple, kale and cucumber juice should hit the spot.

Open seven days a week, the café serves a delicious Sunday Brunch – extremely popular with local families as Joseph's prides itself on being very child-friendly.

The café is licensed and stocks a good selection of wine, beer and cider, including beer from the local microbrewery, the Billerica Brewing Company.

Networking groups use the café regularly for business breakfasts and Joseph's hosts many celebrations such as baby showers and birthday parties. The sisters and their staff also offer a lunch delivery service to high street businesses. They email the day's menu and deliver food orders direct to your desk.

Joseph's Kitchen Café's secluded setting makes it a pleasure to sit outside during the summer months and a cosy haven from the busy high street all year round.
